4. Last Minutes of meeting was read out and passed
5. There was a representation from Enable India Foundation. Their mission is "Empowering Children, youth women for sustainable development". They are located at K8 Katju Nagar, Ground Floor, Kolkata – 700 032. There was a two member team led by Ms. Geeta Venkadakrishnan, (9830201145). They had requested us to allocate space at our ROTA school for conducting various programs for the target community in our RCC area.
